

Evaluation of research entities

Hcéres evaluates publicly certified and financed research entities in five consecutive campaigns covering the whole of France. These entities are primarily research units (équipes d'accueil [research training centres hosting intern students], and unités mixtes de recherche [joint research units]). Other entities evaluated include federative structures, clinical investigation centres, the research departments of university hospitals, technological research institutes and the joint research units of French research units situated abroad.
