Personal data protection policy

The High Council for Evaluation of Research and Higher Education (Hcéres) undertakes to ensure that the collection and processing of your data, carried out via the hceres.fr website, conforms to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the French Data Protection Act (Loi Informatique et Libertés). In accordance with this regulation, a data protection officer has been appointed.

Anyone entering personal information on this website declares that he or she is over 18 years old.

Any collection of personal data on this website is carried out for the purpose of enhancing content, statistical analysis and tracking any requests you may send us, of managing and monitoring the queries you may submit to us, managing and monitoring applications submitted in response to job offers or to the call for candidates to serve as Experts.

These data are collected with your express permission. You have a right of access and erasure as well as the possibility of withdrawing your consent or requesting the portability of your data or restricting their processing: either by using the online tools at your disposal (management of cookies), or by contacting directly the data protection officer.
