Marilena Maniaci is Full Professor of Palaeography at the University of Cassino and Southern Lazio, where she previously worked as a researcher (1998-2005). At her university, she served as Vice Rector for Research and Deputy Rector.

Since April 2020 she holds a temporary mandate as a member of the Governing Board of ANVUR, the Italian National Agency for the Evaluation of Universities and Research Institutions (with specific responsibility for Higher Education Institutions in Art, Music and Dance and for International relationships).

Marilena Maniaci's research activities are chiefly focused on the history of Medieval manuscript books and their scientific description, including the application of innovative methods and technologies.

She is the author of five monographs and over 130 articles and contributions published in high-ranking journals and widely distributed books; she has also edited several collections of essays, in close collaboration with Italian and foreign scholars.

She participated (also in the role of coordinator) in numerous national and European research projects, and regularly collaborates with foreign universities and research bodies (e.g. University of Hamburg, "Centre for the Study of Manuscript Cultures" and Cluster of Excellence "Understanding Written Artifacts"; University of Jyväskylä; University of Oslo; CNRS – IRHT; PSL – Paris Science et Lettres).

She is member of some of the sector's principal associations (e.g. "CIPL – Comité International de Paléographie Latine"; "APICES – Association Paléographique Internationale Culture Ecriture Société"; "AIPD – Associazione Italiana Manoscritti Datati"; "AMD I – Associazione Manoscritti Datati d'Italia"; "Società Internazionale di Storia della Miniatura").

She sits on the scientific board of a number of national and international academic journals (e.g. *COMSt Bulletin*; *Scrineum Rivista*; *Gazette du livre médiéval*; *Fragmentology*) and scholarly series (e.g. *Bibliologia. Elementa ad librorum studia pertinentes*, Brepols; *Spudasmata. Studien zur Klassischen Philologie und ihren Grenzgebieten*, Olms Verlag).

She acts as referee for various research organisations and foreign universities (Austria, Israel, France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, Spain, Serbia and European funding programmes).
